

## **Related QUESTIONS to CONSIDER**

A few of questions before Southern Baptist are ....

1. By weakening local Associations and State Conventions in favor of more nationalized control of strategies, staffing, priorities, and ministry field response, will the SBC evangelistic mission effectiveness, and its financial mission capacity be stronger or weaker?
2. With fewer missionary staff on the ground in associations and state conventions to (1) establish and enhance relational ties and (2) assist both established and new churches in Kingdom advance, will SBC identify, values, and commitment to cooperative mission efforts and funding be enhanced or weakened?
3. With the last loyalty-based generation of Cooperative Program and missions givers passing away, will a nationalize program or a local and state effort be more likely to replace and increase the mission investments of Southern Baptists?
4. Will the evangelism and mission efforts of Southern Baptists be stronger or weaker under this new nationalistic approach and new Cooperative Agreement?
