While serving as a volunteer bi-vocational minister for the last thirty-eight years, God has provided for my family and I by allowing me to hold senior leadership roles in government and industry; for the last ten years as the Founder/President of a successful systems engineering consulting company within the defense industry. I share this simply to say that I have worked with many Christian leaders and Dr. McRaney is a man whose talents would add to any organization. His extraordinary intellect, analytical mind, and passion for the Kingdom are an inspiring example to his peers, ministry partners, friends, and family.

During my twenty-three years of serving with the Baptist Convention of Maryland Delaware, BCM/D (currently operating as the Mid Atlantic Baptist Network), I have not met a more dedicated and capable catalyst for the cause of Christ in this region.
